

Bisphenol-A (BPA) and Bisphenol-S (BPS) Statement

Commission Regulation (EU) 2024/3190 amends the Plastic Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 by adding provisions related to the use of bisphenol A (BPA) and other bisphenols and bisphenol derivatives in food contact materials. This amendment removes BPA (FCM Substance No. 151) and 4,4-dihydroxydiphenyl sulphone (BPS, FCM Substance No. 154) from Annex I of Regulation (EU) No 10/2011. Additionally, a new paragraph in Article 6 of Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 specifies that BPA and other hazardous bisphenols or bisphenol derivatives may only be used in plastic materials and articles in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2024/3190.

We hereby declare that Bisphenol A (BPA, CAS No. 80-05-7) and Bisphenol S (BPS, CAS No. 80-09-1) are not intentionally added to the recycled fiber board produced by Solidus, nor by our plastic suppliers.

Bisphenol-A (BPA):

- BPA is not intentionally added during our production processes, nor is it present in the processing aids we use.
- Any trace levels of BPA that might be present are attributable to the recovered paper used by us and other manufacturers of solid board.
- Migration test results indicate that the BPA content in our products is less than 0.01 mg/kg of food.
- Bisphenol-S (BPS):
- BPS is not detected in our products based on current migration testing methods.
